Reverend Rusty Stone (Leadvocals, Guitars, Harp, Dobro, Mandolin):

His roots are in the Blues and as with his both comusicians the musical horizon does not stop here, many other blues music styles have left an influence. Rusty Stone is an awesome guitarplayer, songwriter, great singer and plays a dirty high-energy slide guitar like a hellhound is on his trail. Comparisons with Rory Gallagher, Jimi Hendrix and Stevie Ray Vaughan are more than justified.

Mr. C. P. (Electric bass, Upright bass, Tuba, Vocals): C.P. plays his instruments with unusual stylistic variety. With his very dynamic and very expressive manner to play he inspires the audience over and over.

Al Wood (Drums, Cajon, Percussion, Vocals): It's a must to see Al Woods impressive playing on the wooden box cajon just with bare hands. Just an extraordinary drummer-greetings from John Bonham/Led Zeppelin.

Only these three musicians are necessary to bring such a stylistic variety on stage, that never will be found pretty soon. The music is an inventory of the guitaroriented Rock – although the jazz and blues roots will never be neglected. For sure they belong to one of the hardest working bands in the livemusic scene. Someone who believes this is an exaggeration, should visit immediately a concert of this trio. Because: Their music is spicy like a T-Bone-Steak and hot like Tex-Mex-Food. Simply a merciless, earthy, indestructible live show with unusual instruments like mandolin, cajon or tuba.

Nu-Bluz, Jam-Rock, Blues-Rock, Roots-Rock, Americana, R'n'B, Boogie, Hardcore-Texas-Shuffle, bonedry Rock'n'Roll and lots of sweat are the cause for the success. It's not rare that concerts last over 3 hours. Thru incredible stagepresence the audience, musicians and critics are everywhere enthralled.

Mixing the roots of the earthy traditional Mississippi-Blues with the music of ZZ Top, Stevie Ray Vaughan, Rory Gallagher, Gov't Mule, Ben Harper and many more.

Three roadwarriors with the roots in the Blues. Long before the sweat dries, you're sure of one thing: like hurricanes, tornadoes and earthquakes, there's no holding back Reverend Rusty & The Case.
